

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MICRO-CREDIT

Loan Program for Entrepreneurs

On 7th December 2022, Loan Program for 20 SHG entrepreneurs at Basin Bridge DBSSS was held. These women were given INR 50,000/- for self-employment. It was graced by Fr. Joseph Leo - SU-RABI Director, Mr. Gokul - Rotary club President, Mr. Ravikumar - Secretary and Mr. Palani (Former President of Rotary Club) and DBSSS animators. Fr. Leo appreciated the willingness of Self-Help Group women to become income earning members of their families as are they are the financial managers of the family. On the occasion of Christmas, he encouraged them to be simple and benevolent. Rotary club members reiterated their constant support and cooperation to make the women financially independent.









Ms. Meena has been running a small hotel with her sister for 8 years. Their hotel offer only breakfast and lunch. We have helped her to own this business entity with 3 loans (Starting with Rs. 20,000, then Rs. 40,000 and Rs. 50,000). She is a good example of timely repayment and motivator of other slum women.

Capacity Building Training for Staff

The capacity building program is the process by which individuals in the organization would improve their skill management and leadership quality. SURABI team had a chance to have the Capacity building program on 21-01-2022. Mr. Mark Antony was the resource person of the day, who led the session on the theme of



"TEAM - Together Everyone Achieve More". This program aimed to build the capacity of staff to participate in the transition process, according to the role and responsibilities they hold, and to prepare staff to take on new roles in different types of services.

Human Rights Awareness Program for Youth

Human Rights Awareness program was organized by the DBSARC team on the Human Rights Day 2022 with the theme "Knowing Rights and Growing Human" at SIHARAM. 160 youth from BRAVE project (Irular, Thurumbar, and Gypsies) from 7 locations (Bagalur, Veeralur, Tirupattur, Visuvasampatti, Gingee, Kurumberi and Irular Vattam) participated. Fr. Christopher initiated an ice-breaking session with some fun activities, and he made the participants understand the fundamental principles of human rights, the importance of human rights, Fundamental, Social and Cultural Rights, Child Rights, women Rights, SC/ST Rights. He briefly explained the UDHR's 30 articles that disregard Untouchability and Discrimination. Participants gained information about their rights and responsibilities at the end of the session. Through action songs, Mr. Ramu made them realize their rights. The participants were given the orientation about the preamble of our Indian Constitution and all recited together. They are now aware of their basic rights to safeguard themselves from exploitation.

Building Effective Solutions Together

Monitoring visit to three project locations

The 3rd year of BEST project monitoring visit was conducted by SURABI Team and Fr. Joseph Leo, SURABI Director. He visited the Evening study centres at Gedilam, Kotagiri and Kadambur between 11th January to 13th January 2023. The objectives of the visit were to know the Awareness level of child protection and safeguarding policy Besides, among the tutors. the verified the placement of Child Safeguarding posters at the project locations. After interacting with the tutors and the children, few guidelines and inputs were shared. No child safeguarding violations occurred in BEST project locations.

15 TOT CSO's each in 2 batches and 20 Key Staff CSOs in 9 Batches




The Negotiation skills training of 2 days each was conducted for 30 TOT members and 180 Key Staff (28 November to 19th December 2022). The training included Negotiation techniques, its types, skills, ethics and characteristics. Various methods of negotiation were taught with practical sessions. It encouraged these 120 CSOs to undertake negotiation services.


Building Resilience and Vocational Excellence

The BRAVE project has begun to implement the activities. The project team visited all the targeted communities and completed the identification of villages, formed Women and Youth Groups, and have organized Orientation training programs. It is very challenging to motivate these vulnerable communities.

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Stimulating Motivating Imaginative Learning Environment

The SMILE project focuses on Evening study centre at DBRITE Cuddalore. An awareness program on Nation Building and Child Rights building was conducted on 29th January for 700 children. The training program used Human rights approach keeping in mind UNCRC and SDGs, legal provisions assigned by the Government. Besides, children celebrated traditional art festival and expressed their child rights through street theatre, dance, singing and mime. The children participated on the traditional and modern day sports activities such as Kabaddi, Football, Marbles, volley ball. As a result of this intervention, 700 children participated and showcased their skills. It may result in these children becoming professionals in future.





Environmental Training for Green Army Members

The Green Army Members training was conducted in 21 Don Bosco schools across Northern Tamil Nadu Districts of Tamil Nadu. It was facilitated by SURABI and Don Bosco Youth Empowerment Services. All these training programmes were conducted in December and January 2023. This intervention reached out to 630 children and all these children were sensitized on Environment issues and importance of Green initiative to create Green Don Bosco Schools across the INM province.




Abdulkalam Nagar, Nayanpakkam village and Vidaiyur are locations covered for this activity. We reached out to 65 families on the occasion of Christmas & New Year. These people are bonded laborers in the rice mills. The children do not study beyond 5th or 6th class. They get incorporated in bonded labour for meanial pay. The girl children are married about 12 years of age. The family (both husband and wife) are paid Rs. 100/- per day. They neither have land asset nor saving possibility. Though the Govt. has allotted Survey Number, Patta is still elusive. The majority community is against the these labourers' upheaval. We collected and distributed Dress Materials, Grocery, Personal Hygienic items, Educational materials, Toys, Eatables & Snacks.

Mr. Rozario, Founder of POPE CSO and who have received Best Social activist by the French Government in 2021 has insisted on the unity to eradicate the poverty among the marginalized communities. Fr. Selva SJ, Loyola College, Vettavalam reiterated the need for Scientific Approach in Networking ability of the CSOs. Insisted on the importance of Survey in the service area of the CSOs; Documenting the emotional impact systematically. Guided the CSO representatives the nuances of collecting information, Documentation, Reporting and Networking.
